



Louis XIII Holdings Ltd. Builds out its Management Team with New Appointments

Mr. Liao also co-founded Amida Capital Group Limited with Stephen Hung, Joint Chairman of Louis XIII Holdings, in 1992.

Danny Chan, appointed Vice President of Engineering & Facilities, joins the Company from Keppel Land China, where he was the Director of Commercial Operations. Mr. Chan has over ten years of experience in Hotels, real estate development and facility management in Asia. He has also served as Director of Property Operations for Wynn Macau, where he managed the hotel’s engineering department. He was also previously Chief Engineer for Disneyland Hong Kong and the Peninsula Hong Kong.
